### EMPOWERMENT IN EVERY BRUSHSTROKE

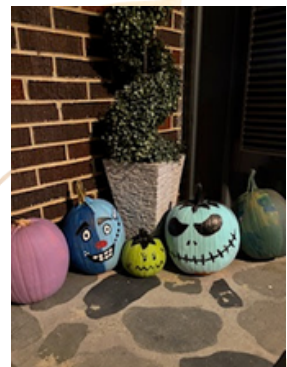
